## GOSPEL ACCLAMATION VERSES

6/5: Come, Holy Spirit, fill the hearts of your faithful and kindle in them the fire of your love.

6/12: Glory to the Father, the Son, and the Holy Spirit; to God who is, who was, and who is to come.

6/19: I am the living bread that came down from heaven, says the Lord; whoever eats this bread will live forever.

6/26: Speak, Lord, your servant is listening; you have the words of everlasting life.

## CHANGE IN PROCEDURES

1. The Communion Antiphon is to begin as the celebrant receives the Body and Blood of Christ (GIRM #86).
2. The Communion Antiphon is to be done in its entirety.
3. If time permits, the Communion hymn may be sung following the antiphon.
4. There must be greater attention and fidelity to tempi. Tempi have been very inconsistent and too slow.
